TRANSITIONS

The Outdoor Classroom has been installed in the playground and is looking amazing. We will work with the children to agree the purpose and rules for this structure. We have also been successful in securing a grant for £2500 which will be spent on developing the school garden in partnership with a local community group, Grow Dunoon. We are



working in partnership with the Cluster Schools growing potatoes. All children will have the opportunity to grow their own tatties – more details to follow.
